The PRO-HDBaseT4P 1x4 4K-HDR HDMI Splitter over Single Cat.x with HDBaseT-Lite, IR, RS-232, PoC & Loopout provides the most cost effective and advanced HDMI splitter solution on the market, by which the high definition video and high quality audio can be transmitted up to 10 different locations without losing quality. PRO-HDBaseT4P supports all 3D formats, the true 4K 2K video and provides two HDMI local loopouts. In addition, PRO-HDBaseT4P is also equipped with bi-directional IR pass-through path and RS-232 serial port control.

With built-in USB firmware update mechanism, the compatibility among countless HDMI sources and receivers can be further guaranteed. With the upmost 12 bit deep color video and high definition audio support, PRO-HDBaseT4P is suitable for high quality HDMI broadcasting, digital signage and education applications!

- 1. Power LED: Power indicator
- 2. Micro-USB: For technical support only [firmware update]
- 3. HDMI Signal LED: Input, Loopout 1, Loopout 2 (from left to right)
- 4. Link Receiver LED: Link LED indicator 1-4
- 5. HDMI Signal LED at Receiver: Output signal LED indicator 1-4

- 6. +12V DC: Connect to the +12V 7.5A power supply unit
- 7. EDID Management Rotary control:

- 9. IR Blaster: Infrared 3.5mm socket for plugging in the extension cable of IR blaster




- 10. IR Receiver: Infrared 3.5mm socket for plugging in the extension cable of IR receiver
- 11. HDMI IN: Connect to a HDMI input source
- 12. HDMI LOOPOUT #1: Connect to a HDMI display with a HDMI male-male cable here
- 13. HDMI LOOPOUT #2: Connect to a HDMI display with a HDMI male-male cable here
- **14. HDMI Signal OUT1-4:** Link to each HDMI display via a Cat-5/5e/6 cable with a HDMI over Cat.X receiver.



- 6. Signal LED: When receiving unit receive the HDMI signal, the LED light will shine

- 7. RJ45: Plug in a Cat-5/5e/6 cable that needs to be linked to the transmitting unit
- 8. IR Receiver: Infrared 3.5mm socket for plugging in the extension cable of IR receiver
- 9. IR Blaster: Infrared 3.5mm socket for plugging in the extension cable of IR blaster
- 10. RS-232(terminal block format): The order of RS-232 pin are TX, RX, GND (from left to right)
- **11. Dip Switch:** for F/W update



IR BLASTER:

plug in the IR blaster to emit all IR command signals received from the IR receiver from the other end to control the devices corresponding to the IR signals.

IR RECEIVER:

plug in the IR receiver to receive all IR command signals from the IR remote controls of the corresponding devices.



CAUTION

Incorrect placement of IR Blaster and Receiver may result in the failure of the IR extenders. Please check carefully before plugging in the IR extender to the respective IR sockets. Warranty will not cover the damage.

You can buy any IR extension cables in the market that are compatible to the definition of the IR sockets for the matrix if necessary for replacement use. However, IR cables longer than 2m (6-ft) may not work.




9. Notice

- 1. Short blackout periods are expected when new monitors are connected to the splitter. The splitter will do Automatic EDID learning which analyzes the newly connected monitor to see if the EDID for the HDMI input is necessary to update!
- 2. Firmware update is proceed through Micro-USB

Main Board

- (1)Power on the device
- (2)Connect the Micro-USB cable between PC and device
- (3)Open firmware update software
- (4)Set the correct COM port and DO NOT click Popular button
- (5)Click the Open Dialog button to open the Firmware Update Tool window



- (6)Click the File button to select the main board firmware file
- (7)Click the Start button and the firmware will start to update
- (8)After updating, please power cycle the device




Input

- (1)Power on the device
- (2)Connect the Micro-USB cable between PC and device
- (3)Open firmware update software
- (4)Set the correct COM port and click button to connect software
- (5)Click the Open Dialog button to open the software folder
- (6)Save the firmware file in this software folder and reconnect the Micro-USB cable
- (7)Open firmware update software and then device will start to update firmware automatically
- (8)After update process is done, software will show "Success" message and then be closed automatically
- (9)After updating, please power cycle the device

Output

- (1)Power on the device
- (2)Connect the Micro-USB cable between PC and device
- (3)Open firmware update software
- (4)Set the correct COM port and click port button to connect software
- (5)Click the Open Dialog button to open the FW Update window



- (6)Click the file button to select the output firmware file
- (7)Click the Start button and the firmware will start to update
- (8)After updating, please power cycle the device



10. Limited Warranty
